Art. 1.1 Preamble

This event will be run in compliance with the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC) including appendices, the FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations (FIA CCRSR) including appendices, the WADA/NADA Codes, and the FIA Anti-Doping Regulations, as amended from time to time. The National Road Traffic Regulations of the countries the event passes shall apply. Unless provided otherwise by these Supplementary Regulations, the provisions of the above Rules and Regulations shall apply.

Any modifications, amendments and/or additions to the Rules and Regulations shall be made in the form of numbered and dated bulletins. Bulletins will be issued by the Organiser, up to the commencement of administrative checks with the approval of the FIA, after the administrative checks by the Stewards of the Meeting. Exceptionally, modifications to the itinerary may be made by the Organiser. Additional information will be published in the Rally Guide. - ① For Private entrant's team the entry fee includes 70smq for 1st car and 50smq for the other cars;

The "Service" ID bracelets will grant access to the service park and intervention to race vehicles (together with the Arm band to enter the Scrutineering) in the case laid down in the Regulations.

In the case where the ID bracelet becomes damaged, the person must get the bracelets replaced by the Organization, in exchange for the damaged one.

Checking by the organisation of this identification will be systematic at each service entrance and HQ zone, and at the entrance of the prize-giving. Presentation of the identity bracelet is compulsory each time it is requested by the Organiser or their representatives.

Any fault remarked by a judge of fact or member of the organisation will result in a 250 € penalty.

The fees NOT include:

- **Stella installation kit**
- **Competitors are required to pay (during Check-In at Administrative Checks) a deposit of 250€ which will be refunded at the end of the event upon return of Stella equipment and cleaning Service Area.**

Art. 4.6 Entry fee refunds

The entry fee shall be refunded in full:

- if the event does not take place
- to teams whose entry application is rejected.

The organiser may partially refund entry fees if a competitor cannot take part in the event due to a duly proved case of force majeure.

Art. 5. Insurance Cover

The entry fee includes the insurance premium to insure civil liability of competitors against all third part risks whilst taking part in the Italian Baja.

The provided indemnity under this special insurance is **€ 25.000.000,00** covering each incident or accident.

- The Organisers decline liability for any accident caused to competitors and competing cars during the whole of the event, any in case of cataclysm, riots, demonstrations, vandalism etc. Competitors and crewmembers will have to suffer all consequences (damages, fines and penalties) created by any accidents. Organisers also decline any liability for breach of the Italian Laws and regulations. Injury to the drivers themselves or damage to participating cars are not covered by this insurance.
- Entrants and drivers are free to take on at their own convenience any individual insurance policy that they deem fit, independently from the above-mentioned liability insurance.
- Vehicles carrying service, auxiliary, and/or any other equivalent special plates issued by the Organiser are not covered by the event's insurance policy. These vehicles circulate under the sole responsibility of their owners and the organizer bears no responsibility for them.
- The Organiser guarantees the recover of the injured driver in the Udine or Pordenone hospital. All medical costs and hospitalization, after repatriation to Europe, remain entirely at the expense of the beneficiary.
Competitors are recommended to take information about the cover afforded by their racing driver's

- licence and take out additional insurance with an insurance company of their choice.

Art. 5.1 Accident reporting

If a driver taking part in the Baja is involved in an accident in which a member of the public sustains physical injury, the driver concerned must report this to the next marshal point. If he fails in observing this rule, the Stewards may impose to the responsible crew a penalty, which may go as far as disqualification.

Un case of accident in the Baja itinerary, competitor or his representative must notify **in writing the Clerk of the Course, the Crew's Relation Officer or the Organizer as soon possible.**

Art. 6. Advertising and Identification

The organiser will provide each crew with the advertising and identification panels, which must be affixed to their vehicles in the stated positions prior to scrutineering. **It is not allowed to cut the panels.**

To keep the time required for the administrative checks to the necessary minimum, make sure to bring and present the following documents:

- Driver's and co-driver's valid driving licences valid for the vehicle entered.
- ASN authorisation for foreign competitors (if required)
- Completion of all details on the entry form
- Car registration papers
- FIA Technical Passport

The Entrant is the only responsible for the validity of the different administrative documents required to participate in the 30° ITALIAN BAJA and in particular the validity of the driving license, vehicle registration papers and the vehicle insurance.

Art. 10. Scrutineering, Sealing and Marking

Competitors must bring their cars to the Parc Fermé within 15 minutes from the end of their Scrutineering

Cars which did not pass Scrutineering must go to the Parc Fermé within 09:00 pm

Any delay will be sanctioned by C.o.C. with a € 100 penalty.

Parc Fermé will open on 7th July at 7:00 am

Art. 10.1 Scrutineering, venue, and time

Cars may be presented at scrutineering by a representative of the team. See programme (SR Art. 3)

Art. 10.1.1 Scrutineering, mandatory documents

- Cars' complete original FIA Homologation Document (if applicable)
- FIA Technical Passport
- SOS / OK board (DIN A3 format)

The installation of the tracking system and the NAV-GPS will be checked at scrutineering.

The complete original FIA homologation form / FIA Technical Passport and all other necessary certifications/documents must be available for final checks.

Art. 10.1.2 Timetable for scrutineering

See programme (SR Art. 3)

Will be presented by Bulletin

Any delay will be sanctioned by C.o.C. with a € 50 penalty.

Art. 10.2 Drivers' safety equipment

All items of clothing including helmets and FHR (Front Head Restraint) intended to be used, e.g. HANS devices, must be presented for scrutineering. They shall be checked for compliance with Appendix L, Chapter III.

The cars must be equipped with the medical kit according to FIA CCRSR Appendix IV-1 and FIA Technical List n°83 and the survival kit according to FIA CCRSR Appendix IV-2.1 and the defined Safety Type (see SR Art. 1.5).

Art. 10.3 Installation of the Safety Tracking System and Navigation System

Art. 10.3.1 Safety Tracking System (FIA CCRSR Art. 12.1)

All vehicles must **only** be fitted with the Safety Tracking System(s) provided by the Organiser. The instruction for the use of the Tracking System is in the Appendix 5 of these Supplementary Regulations.

The rental of these units is included in the registration fee.

The installation will take place before the Scrutineering (see Art.3 of this SR). Tracking Officer will collect the devices from the vehicles at the finish Parc Fermé or service park for retired competitors.

Manual switching on the Tracking System alarm without security reasons (red button) will result in the financial responsibility of the Competitor and may result in the disqualification of the same.

Art. 10.3.2 Navigation System (NAV-GPS; FIA CCRSR Art. 12.2)

Competitors are obliged to be equipped with one or two Navigation System(s) (NAV-GPS) downloaded with the waypoints given by the Organiser. When a crew uses two NAV-GPS, it must indicate in writing, at scrutineering, which of the two will be considered as the official one.

Crews on 30° ITALIAN BAJA will be equipped by the organization with ANUBE'S STELLA system that integrates the «car-to-car communication system» into the GPS. NAV/GPS devices shall be collected during the Scrutineering. Anube will collect the devices from the vehicles at the finish Parc Fermé or service park for retired competitors. The information relevant to the installation of the system on the vehicle is available on the rally website and from ANUBE.

The Competitor must contact directly ANUBE to order the support/power supply kits for this equipment.

The components kit is not included in the entry fee

All competitors on the rally must have this system to pass scrutineering.

This system must be working during the running of each Leg. If it is noted that the system is not functioning due to the crew a penalty of one hour per occasion will be given plus a 300€ fine. The infraction will be reported to the sporting stewards for possible extra sanctions.

Any competitor caught by another competitor must pull over and allow themselves to be overtaken. All competitors who have received 3 requests to overtake (aural warnings) coming from the one and same competitor, in a lapse of time less than or equal to 45s must, in the 15s following the third request, do everything possible to allow the competitor making the request to overtake (if the terrain so allows).

The competitor who has not, in the 15s following the third request to overtake, let the competitor who has made the request pass, will receive penalties as Appendix I Art. 47.3 of 2023 FIA CCRSR.

**The Clerk of the Course will pay a particular attention to the respect of these alerts.
All contested cases will be treated by the Stewards, following an audition with the parties involved.
Depending on the circumstances, other penalties may be imposed at the Stewards discretion.**

Art. 10.3.3 Connection of the Systems (FIA CCRSR Art. 12.3)

The specifications for the standard power connector are laid down in the FIA CCRSR Appendix VI. It is the competitor's responsibility to ensure that the Safety Tracking System(s) and the NAV-GPS always remain permanently connected and switched on with the antenna connected throughout the duration of the competition.

Art. 10.3.4 GPS Data Logger

Vehicles selected by the FIA after the publication of the entry list may be equipped with a GPS Data Logger to monitor their performances during the event.
See FIA CCRSR Article 13.1.

Art. 10.3.5 FIA Accident Data Recorder (ADR)

(See Appendix J, Article 283-2, Accident Data Recorder)

An Accident Data Recorder (ADR) complying with FIA Standard 8872-2018 "Accident Data Recorder" (listed in Technical List no. 88) must be installed in T1 cars manufactured from 2016 that participate in any Championship event. The ADR must be installed in accordance with the FIA ADR Installation Specification and manufacturer user's manual.

Art. 10.3.6 FIA On-Board Surveillance Camera (FIA OBSC)

Vehicles selected by the FIA may be equipped with an FIA OBSC to monitor all activities inside the vehicle during the event.

Art. 10.4 On-Board Cameras

See FIA CCRSR Article 11.

Each Competitor must:

- Fill in the request form available on the Event website (<https://www.italianbaja.it/en/for-pilots/registration/fia-event>) and send it to entry@italianbaja.com before 22nd June 2023;
- Indicate number and position of all the on-boards camera;
- Crews not complying with these will be reported the Stewards;

Team cameras will be identified by an adhesive decal by the Organiser and must be mounted in the vehicle at the time of Scrutineering.

The mountings shall comply with Article 283-2 of Appendix J. All camera positions and mountings used must be shown and approved during Scrutineering before the Start of the competition.

Art. 10.5 Electronic Equipment

Any radio or electronic means of communication, or any other device not expressly permitted in FIA CCRSR regulations is forbidden on board the vehicles.

Art. 11. Other procedures and regulations

Art. 11.1 Drivers' Briefing(s)

See programme (SR Art. 3)

At the first briefing of the event, the participation of at least one crew member is compulsory.

Art. 11.2 Pre-Start Area

- The Pre-Start Area will be set up on the same place of Parc Fermè, competitors MUST enter the Pre-Start Area as per Article 3 Programme of these regulations (from 12:00h to 13:00h).
- **On Friday at 07:00 am Parc Fermè will open and will be given the Time Card for the Pre-Start Area.**
- The Pre-Start Area will be secured. Access is limited to crew members, VIP and media representatives carrying the appropriate identification/accreditation.

- Cars must be driven by one of the Drivers or any Team member representative to the Pre-Start Area where any kind of service is strictly forbidden; Any type of this infringement will be reported to the Stewards and the Team involved will acquire penalty.
- Each entering and any delay in the Pre-Start Area outside the indicated time window according to Art. 3 of these regulations will be sanctioned by C.o.C with a € 100 penalty.

Art. 11.3 Ceremonial start procedures and order

According Art. 30 of the FIA CCRSR.

- The Ceremonial Start will take place in according to Art. 3 of these regulations. It is mandatory for both crew members to attend;
- No time card will be given before competitors go on the ramp;
- The order will be done by a communication of the C.o.C.
- It is mandatory for all Crew members to wear their FIA approved racing overalls, boots, during the Ceremonial Start ramp. Crews not complying with these will be reported the Stewards;
- A Timecard will be given on the ramp (TC0).

Art. 11.4 Electronic start procedure at Selective Sections

According to art. 42.2 of the 2023 FIA CCRSR.

See SR appendix 7

Art. 11.5 Finish procedures

- At the end of Leg 2, all cars are subject to Parc Fermé Rules until the Parc Fermé is opened at the Stewards instruction.
- The Prize giving ceremony will take place at the Interporto Centro Ingrosso "Parterre" at 13:00
- After parking their vehicles in the Parc Fermé upon passing the finish line, participants team (Crew) must remain available by phone (mobile) until the final classification have been posted.
- The Podium & Prize giving will take place according to art.3 of these regulations. It is mandatory for both Crew members to attend.
- The Prize giving will be given in descending order according to the Provisional General Classification.

Art. 11.6 Permitted early check-in.

With reference to Art. 38.2.11 of FIA CCRSR, crews are authorised to check-in ahead of time without incurring a penalty at the following time controls:

TC1A – TC2B – TC3A – TC4A

Art. 11.7 Official time used during the event.

Official time throughout the entire event will be GPS time (Italian Time = GMT+2)

Art. 11.8 Road books delivery

The Organiser will issue the Road Book one day at a time (See programme SR art.3).

The **"WATER - RESISTANT" Road Books** are available to the crews.

Reservations are required no later than the closing date for entry (**22nd June 2023 at 06:00 pm**) to the email entry@italianbaja.com.

The cost of each water - resistant Road Book is € 40.00 per day

Legal entrant's Team Manager can request an additional Paper Road Book

Art. 11.9 Servicing of vehicles

Art. 11.9.1 Service Areas / Bivouacs

The speed of vehicles in the service parks/bivouacs may not exceed **30 kph**

From TC0 onwards, service of a competing car may be carried out in Service Areas (Service Parks and Bivouacs) and road sections as permitted under the FIA CCRSR.

All the Teams which have to go to the own service area have to go before in the Service Accreditation Centre (SAC). **GPS POINT: N 45°56.704' – E 12°40.497'**

SAC will be open on Wednesday 05th July from 03:00 pm to 08:00 pm and Thursday 06th July from 07:30 am to 06:00 pm, and there will receive stickers, service plates, ID bracelets and instructions to follow for the own service area.

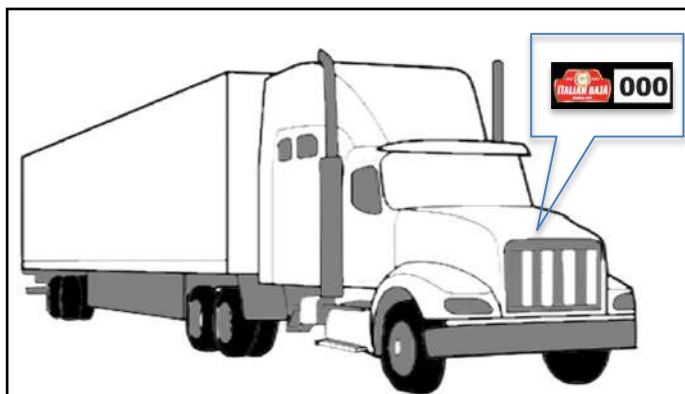
All the Teams will be placed by the Organizer in the Service Areas.

Once positioned, only the service or passenger transport vehicles equipped with a pass (Service, Team Manager) will be able to enter and exit the service park. The rest of the vehicles will not be able to leave the Service Park until the end of the event.

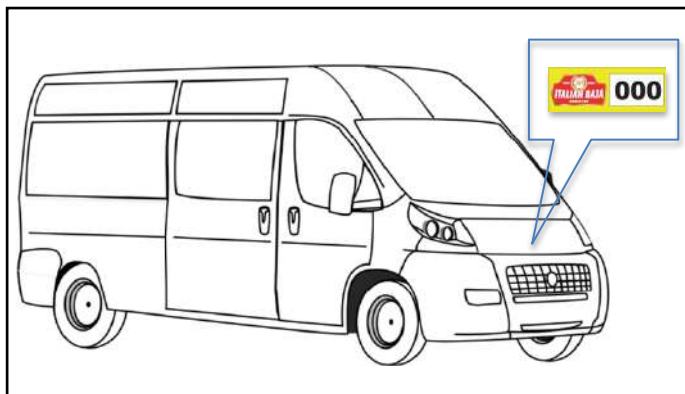

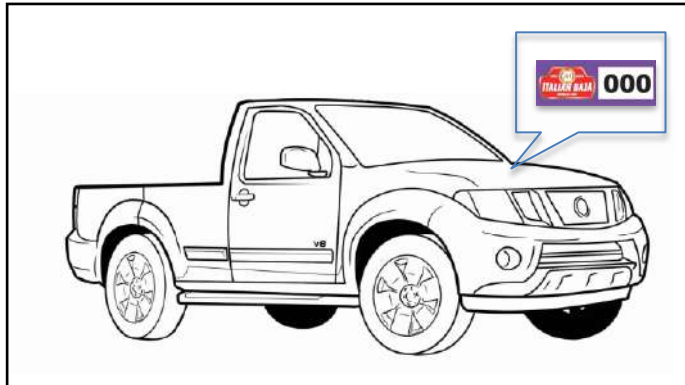

- These vehicles can enter in the service park every day of the event.

Inside the Service Park the staff in charge for servicing the competitor's vehicle must wear their armband supplied by the Organizers during administrative checks in a very visible way.

Art. 11.9.2 Flexi Service

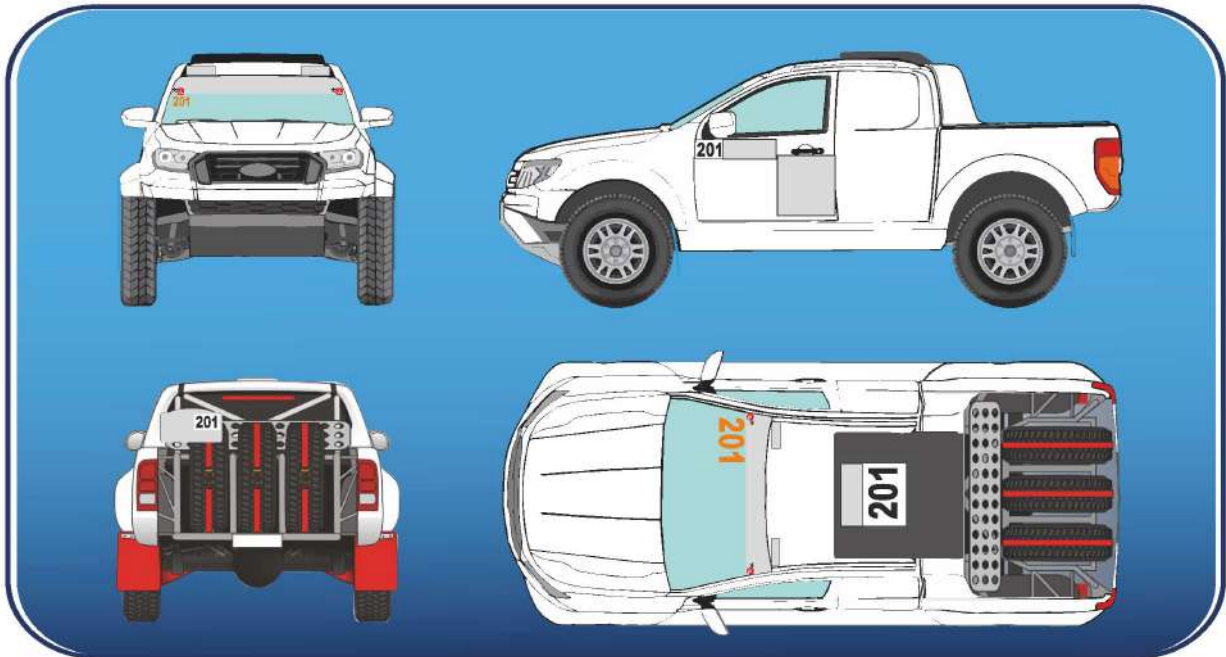
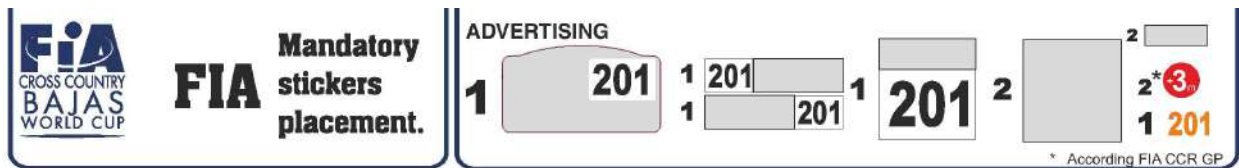

Appendix 4 – Extracts from FIA ISC Appendix L relating to overalls, helmets and any other safety requirements.

All competitors are reminded of Appendix L of the FIA International Sporting Code, in particular its Chapter III - Drivers' Equipment.

Helmets (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 1)

All crews must wear crash helmets homologated to one of the FIA standards listed in Appendix L.

Frontal Head Restraint (FHR, Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3)

All crews must use FIA approved FHR systems homologated to FIA standard 8858.

Approved FHRs, anchorages and tethers are listed in Technical List N° 29.

See also helmet compatibility chart in Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 3.3.

Flame-resistant clothing (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2)

All drivers and co-drivers must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2018 (Technical List N° 74). Please pay special attention to the prescriptions of Art. 2 **concerning the correct wearing of the clothing elements! See also FIA Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations Article 47.1.**

Any FIA-approved 8856-2018 garment customised using printing or transfers must be accompanied by a certificate from the manufacturer.

FIA Priority drivers (and accompanying co-drivers) must wear overalls as well as gloves (optional for co-drivers), long underwear, a balaclava, socks and shoes homologated to the FIA 8856-2018 standard (Technical List No 74).

Biometric Devices (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 2.1)

Drivers may wear a device to collect biometric data during racing.

- If the biometric device is integrated into a protective garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856, the garment shall be homologated to FIA Standards 8856 and 8868-2018.
- If the biometric device is a stand-alone device, then the device must be homologated to FIA Standard 8868-2018 only. This device must be worn in addition to the garment homologated to FIA Standard 8856.

Wearing of jewellery (Appendix L, Chapter III, Art. 5)

The wearing of jewellery in the form of body piercing or metal neck chains is prohibited during the competition and may therefore be checked before the start.

MEDICAL AND SURVIVAL KIT (Appendix IV of the Cross-Country Rally Sporting Regulations)

A sealed and valid Medical kit in accordance with the Specification for Cross Country Rallies and Bajas (Technical List n°83) must be placed inside the cockpit. The minimum weight must comply with Technical List n°83.
